Passive voice

Passive voice is formed with the help of the verb to be (in the tense required by the situation) accompanied by the Past participle of the main verb.

Tense		Active voice	Passive voice	Examples
Present Simple	Affirmative	They treat	They are treated	His position in bed is changed every two hours.
	Negative	He sees	He is not seen	His cavities are treated every six months.
	Interrogative	Does she follow?	Is she followed?	Are the procedures followed correctly?
Past tense	Affirmative	He transported	El was transported	El was transported to hospital 20 hours ago. (<i>yesterday/last week</i>)
	Negative	They did not prepare	They were not prepared	The patients were not prepared for the transfer.
	Interrogative	Did she monitor?	Was she monitored?	Was his temperature monitored?
Present Perfect	Affirmative	He has monitored	He has been monitored	He has been monitored lately/ for the past two days/ this week.
	Negative	He has not monitored	He has not been monitored	He has not been monitored lately/ for the past two days/ this week.
	Interrogative	He has monitored	Has he been monitored?	Has he been monitored lately/ for the past two days/ this week?
Future	Affirmative	You will change	You will be changed	This medicine will be changed .
